ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT OF  
The Sandwich Home Industries

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this non-profit corporation shall be The Sandwich Home Industries.

ARTICLE II

Objects

The objects for which this corporation is established and its general purposes are and shall be to promote education and training in arts and crafts in the Town of Sandwich and elsewhere in the State of New Hampshire; to encourage craftsmen in the Town of Sandwich and elsewhere in the State of New Hampshire through efficient cooperative marketing of their products, but not to engage in any business for profit; and to unite in closer fellowship all those who are striving for higher standards in arts and crafts.

No part of the net income of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private member or individual, and no member, officer or employee of the corporation shall receive or be lawfully entitled to receive any pecuniary profit of any kind therefrom, except reasonable compensation for services actually rendered in effecting one or more of its purposes. The corporation shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, and it shall not participate or interfere in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

In the event of dissolution of the corporation no distribution of any of the property or assets of the corporation shall be made to its directors, members, or officers, or to any individual, but all of the property and assets shall be applied to the continued furtherance of the forementioned purposes in a manner consistent with the provisions of the preceding paragraph.

ARTICLE III

There shall be no capital stock of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall be governed by a Council of not less than 21 nor more than 30 members. The manner of electing members of the Council and their duties, powers, and terms of office shall be established by By-Laws.

Provisions for membership in the corporation and classification of memberships shall be established by By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have authority to receive, by purchase, gift, grant, devise, bequest or in any other lawful manner, any real or personal property, and to hold, use, improve, operate, manage, lease, convey, convert, invest, dispose of by gift, sale, lease or otherwise, and transfer any or all of such real or personal property, and to use the same in any lawful manner for the furtherance of its general purposes, and to do and perform generally and anywhere all acts and things reasonably incident to such purposes, including the establishment, augmentation and administration of any fund or funds which may be reasonably advantageous or convenient to the carrying out of the corporation's purposes and to disburse and expend the same and the income and earnings thereof, to promote its purposes either for itself or as agent, trustee or representative of others.

The corporation shall have power to transfer, assign and convey any assets or property which it may receive by gift or devise in accordance with the provisions or conditions authorizing such transfer contained in the instrument evidencing the gift or devise of such property.

ARTICLE VI

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be in the Town of Sandwich, New Hampshire, and it may have other places of business in such places as the Council may from time to time designate.
