In her lecture titled “Building a Park to Find Hope,” Kathryn Field will speak about the creation of a sculpture she created for the entrance to Betsy’s Park. Betsy’s Park was created to find hope and honor the memory of Betsy O’Leary and her unborn daughter who were both killed in a tragic accident. Betsy was a student of Kathryn’s at Holderness school and her parents asked Kathryn to create a sculpture that celebrated her life and welcomed the community to the park. Kathryn has created sculpture for the past 4 decades of work in Bronze, Steel, Stone, and Wood. Most of her public sculptures are in Chicago but many of you have enjoyed seeing her work this summer in Meredith. There, her stainless-steel Loon sculpture graces the shore of Lake Winnepesaukee as part of the Meredith Sculpture Walk. This fall another large sculpture was dedicated at Betsy’s Park in Holderness on White Oak Park. This lecture will introduce the process of creating a sculpture from the ground up.

Her work has been featured in major textile art publications and shown in national and international exhibitions. Sara has traveled throughout the world in the pursuit of textiles to: Guatemala, Mexico, Peru, Japan, Indonesia, Nepal, India, and China.

At the Benz Center Sara will show slides of both her work in process as well as actual finished pieces. Images of her travels to some of the great traditional textile places in the world will be included.
